In 1968, Ken Anderson began the engineering firm of Anderson & Associates, Inc. (A&A) from his home in Blacksburg, Virginia while working towards his Master's degree at Virginia Tech. Due to his leadership and vision and the quality employees, the company continues to grow with the times and the community, staying consistently on the cutting edge of technology and managerial style.

Mr. Anderson has helped A&A become widely known as a leader and an innovator in using technology to improve the quality and timeliness of the engineering practice. He was appointed by former Governor George Allen to the *Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board*. Mr. Anderson was selected as one of the 200 business leaders and economic developers from around the state who helped draft a "blueprint" for science and technology for the Commonwealth. He is a founding member of the Board of Directors of *Blacksburg Electronic Village, Inc.* He is also the legislative chairman of the *Virginia Association for Mapping and Land Information Systems (VAMLIS)*.

Mr. Anderson is the Co-Vice Chair of the *New Century Council*, a regional citizen strategic planning group centered on the New River and Roanoke Valleys. He also co-chairs the Economic Development Committee of Ninth District Congressman Rick Boucher's *Commission on the Future of Southwest Virginia*. He is a member of the Advisory Board of the Virginia Tech *Center for Transportation Research*, a member of the Virginia Tech *Economic Development Advisory Committee* and a member of the board of the *Virginia Mathematics and Science Coalition*. He is also on the Board of Directors for the *Virginia Chamber of Commerce*.

Mr. Anderson has served as President of the *Virginia Society of Professional Engineers* and as Vice President of the *Consulting Engineers Council of Virginia*. He is a member of the Virginia Tech *School of Engineering Committee of 100* and has served as Chair of the Virginia Tech *Civil Engineering Alumni Board*. He also serves on Virginia Joint Commission on Technology and Science Economic Development Committee.

The idea of flattening the corporate hierarchy and empowering the work force is the backbone of the management style at A&A. Mr. Anderson has been honored for his support of entrepreneurial programs as a finalist for the Virginia Entrepreneur of the Year Awards.

Mr. Anderson also serves on the *American Arbitration Association Construction Industry Panel* and has participated in three arbitrations. He serves as a peer reviewer for the *American Consulting Engineers Council* and has performed reviews of the operations of more than ten firms across the United States.
