Download data?

Please note: This feature is currently only available on Franklin County's WebGIS site.

If you currently do a search for a parcel on Franklin County's WebGIS site, you can download the results to a spreadsheet. Currently, the only downloadable data is the parcel owner, coowner and parcel ID information. To download, click download data in the right hand side of your search results. Franklin County's parcel data is in development, and will be completed as funding becomes available. Need more information on how to do download the data? Password Protected Layers?

Are you interested in having part or all of your WebGIS layers restricted? We now are offering restricted WebGIS sites. The restricted site would give you two levels, one as an administrator and one as a subscriber. Features of both the administrator and subscriber are below:

- When logged in as an administrator you'll be able to add/remove users as well as see all available layers and attributes.
- The Subscriber group does not see any restricted layers, but they can see more information for a fee, then the public site. This group does not have the ability to modify users or groups.
- The public site would not see any layers or information that only subscribers and administrators have access to, such as owner names.
