In an effort to better manage approximately 188,592 water and sewer utility assets in the Winston-Salem and Forsyth County service area, the City Information Technology Department decided to incorporate GIS mapping technologies with their existing Hansen work order management system. A&A helped the City by creating and integrating water and sewer utility GIS mapping data layers into their Hansen system. The City/County Utility is now able to better track maintenance efforts and the associated crew and equipment costs. Need imagery without the contractual limitations or the high costs?

We recently ordered imagery from USDA for Buckingham County. The USDA flew this imagery in 2003 at a photo scale of 1:40000. This photography has been ortho-rectified and is full natural color at 1 meter resolution. We were able to put this imagery on WebGIS without any limitations or having to degrade it.
